- Intensive Outpatient care for adolescents and adults with mental health and co-occurring substance use disorders at our Outpatient Clinics in Bridgeport and Norwalk


- Specialized Intensive Outpatient care for persons of Latino descent in our Bridgeport location

Serves teens starting at the age of 13. Adolescents and their multi-disciplinary team collaborate in developing an individualized treatment plan including psychiatric evaluations with medication management, group therapy, and individual and family sessions.

The program provides therapy for adolescents experiencing:

- Psychiatric problems
- Emotional and/or behavioral difficulties
- Family conflict
- Problems at school
